Built in Austria in 1975 and refurbished in 2012 . A 4-deck vessel equipped with sophisticated navigation devices and modern facilities.





# **PROGRAMME**

# **Moscow – St.Petersburg 11 nights**

### DAY 1 - MONDAY 5: ITALY / MOSCOW

Departure from Genoa at 7.15 by plane. Alitalia flight to Rome and from .Rome to-Moscow. Arrival at Moscow and transfer to the river cruise ship Evening meal on board



# DAY 2 – TUESDAY 6: MOSCOW

Breakfast on board. City sightseeing tour including the Cremlin. and a visit to a Cathedral. Lunch at a restaurant. In the afternoon, the sightseeing tour will include the Red Square and its main sights, St. Basil's Cathedral, the Bolshoy Theatre, the university area, etc. Supper on board

DAY 3 – WEDNESDAY 7: MOSCOW

Full board on the vessel. Day free to do what you want or to go on the **optional excursions to Serghjev Posad**.





### DAY 4 – THURSDAY 8 - UGLICH

Full board on the vessel

Stop at the picturesque Uglich situated on the right bank of the Volga River. Visit to the renowned Cathedral of Transfiguration Next, visit to the Church of St. Dmitry on the Blood,

### DAY 5 FRIDAY 9: YAROSLAV

The next port of call is Yaroslavl,. City tour and visit to the 17th century Church of St. Ilya the Prophet and to the Savior-Transfiguration Monastery. Full board





### DAY 6 - SATURDAY 10: GORITZY

The ship arrives in Goritsy. Visit to the grounds of the 14th century Cyril-Belozersky Monastery, named in honour of its founder, the monk Cyril. Full board

### DAY 7 – SUNDAY 11: KIZ HI

The ship stops at the tiny island of Kizhi, located at the northern end of Lake Onega. Visit of the island including the open-air Museum of Wooden Architecture, housing a collection of restored 18th century Russian wooden buildings, and the Church of the Transfiguration. Full board



Today takes you to the picturesque village of Mandrogi located on the River Svir. A relaxing stop on the Verdant River Bank to enjoy a picnic lunch. In the evening, the ship's captain farewell dinner.

### DAY 9 TUESDAY 1: ST. PETERSBURG

Sightseeing tour in St. Petersburg with its many palaces driving along Nevsky Prospect, the main boulevard of St. Petersburg lined with shops and baroque buildings. Visit to Peter Paus Fortress. Lunch at a restaurant. In the afternoon free time or optional visit to Petrodvorets Palace In the evening optional tour on the canals.

### DAY 10 WEDNESDAY 14: ST. PETERSBURG

Visit to the Hermitage Museum. The rival of the Louvre in Paris, the Hermitage contains three million exhibits and early collections dating back to Catherine II In the afternoon **optional excursion to Pushkin Palace** 


### DAY 11 THURSDAY 15 - ST. PETERSBURG

# **USEFUL INFORMATION**

### DOCUMENTs

Passport valid for at least 6 months from the date of return and visa issued by the Russian consulates in Italy. The Travel Agency will see to the visas upon presentation, at least 30 days before departure, of the appropriate form, correctly filled in, together with the passport and passport photo, signed at the back

#### WEATHER

June is the best summer month The sun sets very late (White nights). Max average temp. 21 degrees - min average temp by night 11 degrees. Little rain.

- **TIME:** One hour more than in Italy.
- LANGUAGE: The official language is Russian, and the alphabet is Cyrillic.

### CURRENCY

The Russian currency is the ruble, which corresponds to approximately 1/60 euros. At current exchange rates.  $\in I = about Rub 69 and Rub 100 = about \in 1.45$  (i.e less than one euro and a half) Credit cards are accepted almost everywhere in the places frequented by foreign tourists. The currency declaration for those entering in Russia is compulsory only in case of amounts exceeding 2,000 (two thousand) US Dollars.

### COINS AND BANK NOTES

The Ruble (rubl ', rubli- Symbol py6 and R) is divided into 100 kopecks (kopeks, Kopecki). Coins: 1, 5, 10, 50 kopeks and 1, 2, 5, 10 rubles - Banknotes: 5, 10, 50, 100, 500, 1000, 5000 rubles.

#### ELECTRICITY

It is supplied at 220V / 50Hz. The sockets are similar to the Italian ones. Type C and Type F. Adapters are not usually necessary.

### PHONES

Calls (roaming) are very expensive.

To save money, it is possible to buy a Russian SIM including 400 minutes of calls and 3 Gb Internet connection for about 400 rubles (just over 5 euro, making the change). The SIM are easy to buy (airports, stations, shops), you just need your passport.

### • Local transport

Fares are similar to the ones here, possibly a little lower. Before taking a taxi, negotiate the fare.
