The school classrooms are located in the main premises in Darsena (years 1 and 2) and in the annexes in via Dino Col (years 3, 4, 5)

There has been a continuous increase in the number of students attending the school. They are now 1,044. In the long history of our school, the number of students enrolled has been of over 1,000 for only 7 times, the highest number of enrolments (1,112) dating back to 1979-'80 when the school premises were located in Piazza Palermo and Corso Galilei.

I.T. Nautico San Giorgio has also become truly international. The number of foreign students attending the school has, in fact, gradually increased over the past years. Now, they are 107 (98 boys and 9 girls), i.e. 10.2% of all the students, and come from 27 different countries.


