Inauguration of *Istituto Comprensivo Foce* in the former premises of *ITN "San Giorgio*" in *Piazza Palermo*

On 15 February, we were invited to the inauguration of the new premises of *Istituto Comprensivo Foce*. The school will be housed in the renovated building in *Piazza Palermo* which used to be the seat of out School, the mythical *Istituto Tecnico Nautico "San Giorgio"*

Several local personalities were present: public officials and executives, such as the Aldeman of Genoa *LL.PP*. and Maintenance, members of the Direction of the renovation works, the President of *Municipio VIII - Medio Levante*, managers and officials, regional and municipal Councillors, the Headmistress and the teachers of *Istituto Comprensivo Foce*, prof. PRESENTATION OF THE BOOK

On 16 february , the book "Navigando sul mare dei ricordi" was finally presented.

The idea of the book had been conceived by our late friend Gianluigi Figari, had been approved in the 2016 General Assembly and had been entrusted to the Board of Directors.

The book is made up of stories written by about thirty of our members. It contains episodes related to their life experiences at sea.

Ivo Degl'Innocenti devoted time to transcribe the stories on a word processor (some were written by hand) and present them at their best. He was supported by Dino Fioravanti, Virgilio Bozzo, Luigi Sartori and some of the authors

The presentation ceremony took place in *"Nautico San Giorgio"* Auditorium in *Calata Darsena*. Several members, with relatives and friends were present,

In my role of President of the Association, I wish to thank all the people present and in particular:

I also thank the Headmistress of the school and her vice **Prof. Marina Nicora** for the hospitality (the deployment of students in their uniforms was impressive) who recollected her years of teaching at the school, in particular the years spent in *Piazza Palermo* building,

Pref. Angela Pasterine who was absent for commitments outside Genoa, managed to arrive in time for the final greetings. Other public figures who had been invited but had been unable to come sent their best wishes.

Both the authors and the Board of Directors had looked forward to the day with some concern but all anxiety or fear was dispelled by our dearest friend, **Prof. Maria Stella Rollandi**, teacher of Economic History and History of International Economic Relations *at Dipartimento di Economia*, Her culture and competence in maritime economic history is superb.

Prof. Rollandi had accepted to present the book and write a preface to the book.

She appreciated the stories both in content and language and underlined their connections with the historical events of the time (mainly the fifties and sixties).

She outlined the figure of the seafarers of those days and their commitment to safety.

She talked about the "Liberty" ships and their role in the Italian economic recovery after the Second World War. She mentioned the mythical *M/n Sestriere*, built in Italy and launched in 1942. After the end of the war, she ferried about one thousand seafarers to the States in order to man 50 Liberty Ships bought there by Italian shipowners.

Prof. Rollandi's presentation was a great success.

After her presentation, **Com.te Oreste Del Conte** decribed the design and building of the American and British Liberty ships as well as their characteristics: structures, propulsion, seaworthiness, cargo (bulk and fuel), and so on. He, too, spoke about *M/n "Sestriere"* and her specific characteristics.

After that, **Com.te Aldo Baffo** told with humour about his experiences on board and in the visited ports

Mrs Nini Cassanello spoke about the work directed by her father at *Officine Meccaniche Navali Campanella*, the first to be carried out in Italy, to assemble the the forebody and the after body of two Liberty ships to build the "*Boccadasse*", a "super-Liberty", the longest ship in those days.(she was scrapped in La Spezia in 1962).

The ceremony was concluded with the traditional wish of "Buon Vento" and a toast.
