Date: 24 March



Talk: "ANTARTIDE Laboratorio a Cielo Aperto della Scienza Internazionale"

Speakers

- **Prof. Giovanni Capponi**, professore ordinario GEO/03 – Geologia strutturale del DISTAV – Università di Genova
- **Dott. Stefano Schiaparelli**, Ricercatore Area 05 – Biologia e Responsabile scientifico del MNA

The speakers called Antarctica an open-air lab, a continent which is still largely unknown. They described how people staying there for a research period can adapt to extreme conditions and talked about their difficulties in reaching the bases, about the means and equipment needed to make life less difficult there and about the equipment for the collection of useful data.

The movies and the pictures they projected showed glacial landscapes and the local fauna (in particular penguins).

The event was supported by **Prof. Wladimiro Iozzi**, former Headmaster of *I.T. Nautico S. Giorgio* of Genoa.

The talk focused on the life and career of the young seafarers on board sailing vessels when the power of the Genoese Republic was declining.

Date: 3/4/5 May

Event:

National Competition of *Istituti Tecnici Trasporti e Logistica* (Deck and Engine)

3 May- opening ceremony

4 May – written contest in *Camogli*

5 May - Practice Test in Genoa (deck on board the school sailing vessels, engine in the engine and electro-technical labs)

This is a yearly competition aiming at verifying the knowledge, skills and performance levels of the students and to promote an exchange of experiences between different socio-cultural realities

Since Miss. *Arianna Carelli*, a student of IV CI at *Camogli*, won the 2016 edition of the games for *CAIM* (Engine), Genoa was the seat for this year's contest.

Pupils of 19 maritime schools of our Peninsula who attend the IV year of course took part in the competition.

The representatives of the Municipalities of Genoa and *Camogli*, of *USR Liguria*, of the Command of the Harbour Master's Office, of the College of Captains, of the world of work and of our Association attended the event.

Date: May 2 to 11,

A delegation of ten students and two teachers from Guangzhou Maritime University of Canton (China) visited the school. The collaboration between the school and the Chinese University dates back to 2008 with the signing of the first protocol of intents aimed at developing ties of friendship between the two peoples, mutual cooperation between maritime training systems and mutual knowledge of the respective culture and language .

Date: 6 to 12 May

A group of 10 students and a professor from Aboa Mare School, Novia University of Turku (Finland) visited the school on an Erasmus + MariePRO Student Exchange Project.

The exchange is aimed at sharing training paths and involved the creation of a mixed class consisting of 10 Italian students and 10 Finnish students attending innovative courses in Finland and Italy from 29 April to 12 May.

First, ten students from class V CNA C (deck) of *Camogli* attended a course in Finland on MRM (Marine Resource Management)

The MRM course made use of simulators to analyse cases of excessive confidence with navigation procedures likely to lead to accidents. It aimed at training the learners in situation awareness so as to prevent accidents due to human error.

The following week, 10 Finnish students came to Italy to follow a Marine Environment Awareness Course (MEA)

The MEA course focused on pollution prevention by using role playing and simulation.

The high quality of the courses, with simulations of situations similar to the ones that arise at sea, can develop awareness of what life on board is like and of its problems. It makes students face new and stimulating situations and can better prepare them for a future in a multicultural maritime environment.

Date: Saturday, 24 June



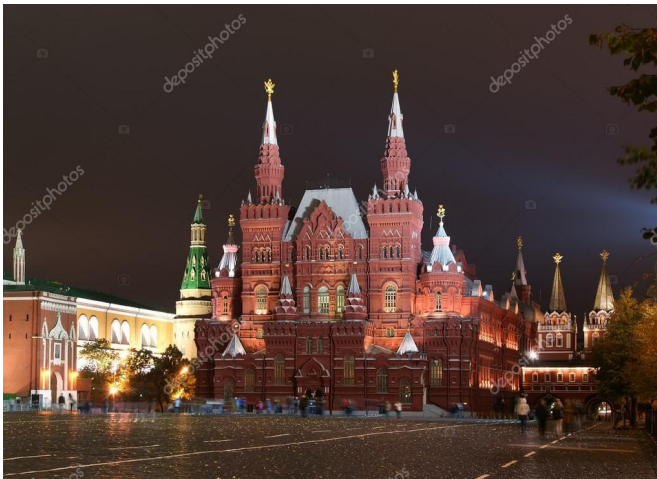

Beautiful the halls of the Grand Palace even though it was severely damaged during the German occupation of the Second World War



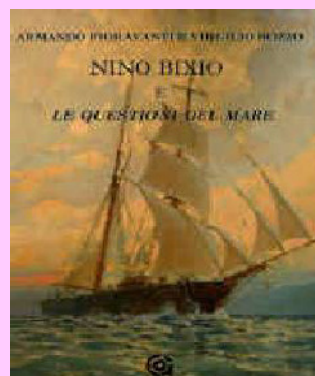
Reminders
