We wish the best to last year school leavers (the ones who will become seafarers, the ones who will work ashore and the ones who will go on to further studies). and to the "primini" who are just going to start studying at Nautico.

The holidays, however, were scarred by a tragic event: the collapse of Morandi Bridge. There are no words to define what happened and how we feel.

The Association is close to the families of the victims and to all those who are suffering as a result of the collapse.

Genoa, often plagued by floods, now must face an emergency whose consequences are currently unforeseeable. With the benefit of hindsight we can complain about necessary works not carried out, neglect, greed, forgetfulness, and so on It's bothering to think no plan for diverting traffic in a similar event had been devised.

Genoa is a very important part in Staly and therefore should have adequate infrastructures and fast connections by land to the hinterland

At the end of the seventies, a guy told me that Genoa should focus on tourism. I did not agree, then, since the part was still the first in the Mediterranean. But he might have been right, because in less than farty years the town has been affected by huge economic and industrial crises and is still without adequate rail and road connections with the hinterland. On the other hand the town has been at the centre of major cultural events and today there is a significant increase in tourism.

Before closing $\mathcal S$ would also add that our schools still lack the necessary facilities and equipment to meet the requirements of the world of work. It is even rare for school buildings to be adequate to withstand seismic events

Thanks to your help, with the work of my students and mine, we managed not only to bring her back to life, after her launching on 22 October, 2016, but also to cut a fine show at recent events and shows.

On Saturday, September 22nd, we participated in the Millevele Regatta in Genoa, our first race, taking the 58th position out of 76 participants, an exceptional result considering the age and weight of the boat compared to that of the modern competitors.

At the beginning of September we took the boat to Imperia to take part in the Raduno Vele d'Epoca, where Nina was able to parade for 4 days next to her contemporaries, without cutting a poor figure.



We are very proud, because it was the splendid result of the long work of the crew, of many other students and mine. So many hardships and so many obstacles overcome since the beginning of this challenge that began three years ago, and that now begins to show the first results. This is why we are grateful to all those who have helped us, providing us with the necessary support to purchase the devices and equipment to restore the boat and make it beautiful and safe. Thanks to your important contribution, we have purchased the tools, the anoraks and the boots for the entire crew, the cooker, the nautical charts and the refrigerator. We would never have found any other sponsors nor the money to buy them.
