### ***A Letter from the Headmaster Prof. Paolo Fasce***

Dear friends of "Associazione Ex alunni e docenti del Nautico San Giorgio",

This is the first time that I write for *La Carretta* because I have been Headmaster of this school only since 1 September of this year. Joking, I have said several times that I am proud to be the first man to succeed the first woman as Head of *Nautico* of Genoa. Angela always points out that nowadays the majority of the Italian maritime school Heads are women and for me this is positive.

I got in contact with the Association immediately and since I have learnt that you wish to collaborate to promote our school, I have decided to ask you a favour.

Here after (see La Carretta Supplement 140B) there is a leaflet meant to be handed out to middle schools students to promote the enrollments to our school. You will notice that other technical schools are included because Nautico is part of a network of technical schools. It is important for us to be promoted all for two reasons.

1. Italy is a manufacturing country and needs technicians of all kinds.
2. I have the honour of being the Head of the largest technical school in the province so it is fair to work in synergy with the other schools and avoid 'cannibalizing ' students since, in the future, the other technical schools could help us.

My school appreciates your attention and help and what I ask you is to identify the middle schools closest to your homes, to learn what time classes are over and students leave the school buildings and to hand them out these leaflets .

It is important that the date of our Open Day which is held on Saturday December 14th is known and therefore the leaflets should be handed out before that date to the schools (those close to *Nautico* and the ones from *Sampierdarena* to *Centro Storico*, from *Castelletto* to *Brignole* would do)

I thank you for your collaboration and, I, too, conclude with ZUMBAI!
